If under 18, the signature, ID, and proof of address of a parent or guardian is required to obtain a library card.

Computer Access in the Library

With a library card or Guest Pass (show ID), patrons receive 2 hours per day of computer access. Use our computers to access the internet, Microsoft Office, and print. **Print rates:** 15¢ per page for black and white, 25¢ per double-sided black and white page, or 50¢ per page for color. Documents may also be emailed to mhlpatron@gmail.com to be printed.
